



2010 USA TEAM NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS PRESS RELEASES: FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

Krupa Wins the Sprint Race and leads Full Throttle Endurance 4-PEAT at the USA Triathlon Team Championships

Myrtle Beach S.C. October 2nd, 2010 — Full Throttle Endurance Racing (FTE) dominated the USA Triathlon Team Championships for the fourth consecutive year with 421 points; second place was Team Fraser Multisport with 289 points. The swim was cancelled due to poor water quality, but Team FTE rolled onto victory anyway with 28 athletes on the Racing Podium.

Sprint Race:

Coach Rick Krupa went wire to wire in the Sprint Triathlon to win the Overall Title of Sprint Champion. John Profaci, Joe Marinucci, Benjie Aiello, Tom Saito were all in the top 10 Overall as well as winning their Divisions. Coach Dan Ownes made Jamis Bicycles proud with the fastest bike split of the day in the Sprint Race holding 26.4 mph avg for 8.2 miles and won his division. Adam Fitzer, Lyle Maltz and Bryan Touhey were all on the podium.

Toni Weeks led the females by winning her division. Other Full Throttle females in the Sprint Top 15 Overall were Becca Brown and Kelly Dooley.

Olympic Race:

In the Olympic Distance Race Bill Kelly lead the Full Throttle Team with a Division Win and 6th Overall, the sweep in that division being completed when Scott Stallwood and Richard Vecchiolla took 2nd and 3rd. Zach Iscol was 15th Overall and 3rd in his division. Tom Slon and Coach Scott Berlinger won their Divisions. Berlinger had the 3rd fastest bike split of the day in the Olympic Race on his Jamis TT with a 24.9 mph avg for 28 miles. Chip Foley was on the podium 2nd in his division.

The females were lead by Stacy Creamer who was a Division Winner and 4th Overall. Anna Hillegass, Amy Catlin, and Karen Phillips were all on the podium and in the Top 15 Overall. Jessica Mullin and Stasi Lubansky were Division Winners. Clare Duffy was 2nd in her division.

Aquabike:

Coaches Andrew Kalley and Chris Coffin were 1st and 2nd Overall in the Aquabike Division and Maria Mahn was 3rd Overall for the females, which became a 56 mile Cycling Time Trial after the swim was cancelled.
